FINAL ORDER

On the 22rd day of August 2008, West Virginia Board of Examiners of Psychologists (Board) reviewed the Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law and Recommended Decision of the Hearing Examiner in the above-styled action. - _____1. The Board shall adopt and ratify the Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law entered on June 17, 2008.
- 2. Effective immediately, the psychology license of Richard R. Boone, Ph.D. (Respondent), License No. 663, is hereby REVOKED.
 - 3. That the Respondent shall be assessed a fine in the amount Five Hundred

Dollars (\$500.00).

That the Respondent shall reimburse the Board in the amount of Three 4. Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for the costs incurred by the Board associated with the investigation and prosecution of this matter. Such payment shall be paid to the Board in full within six (6) months of the date of entry of this Order.

Pursuant the West Virginia Code §29A-5-4(b) an appeal of this decision may be made to the Circuit Court of Kanawha County or in the circuit court of the county in which the licensee resides or does business. This appeal must be filed within 30 days after receiving this decision.
